Sri Sri Ravi Shankar conferred award by German organisation

Spiritual leader and Art of Living Founder, Sri Sri Ravi Shankar, was today conferred the 2009 Culture in Balance Award, in recognition of his outstanding contribution to all facets of culture, and for his commitment to global cultural balance.
